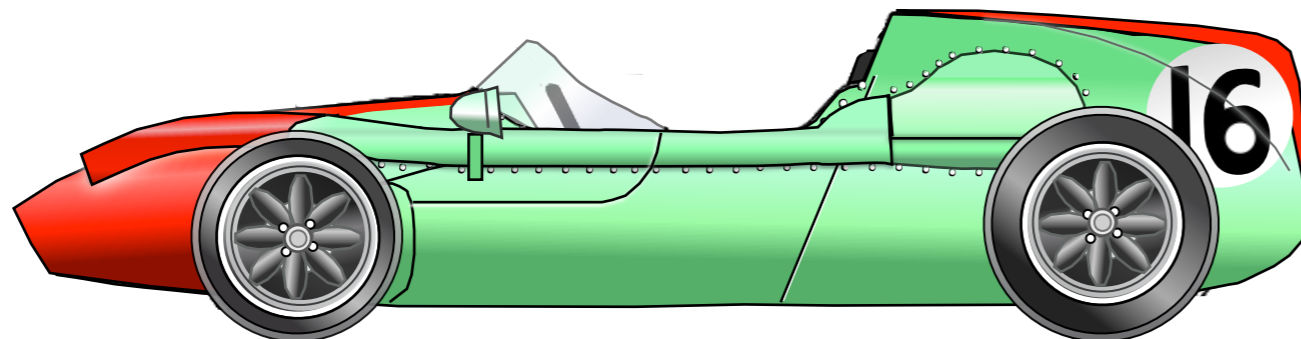
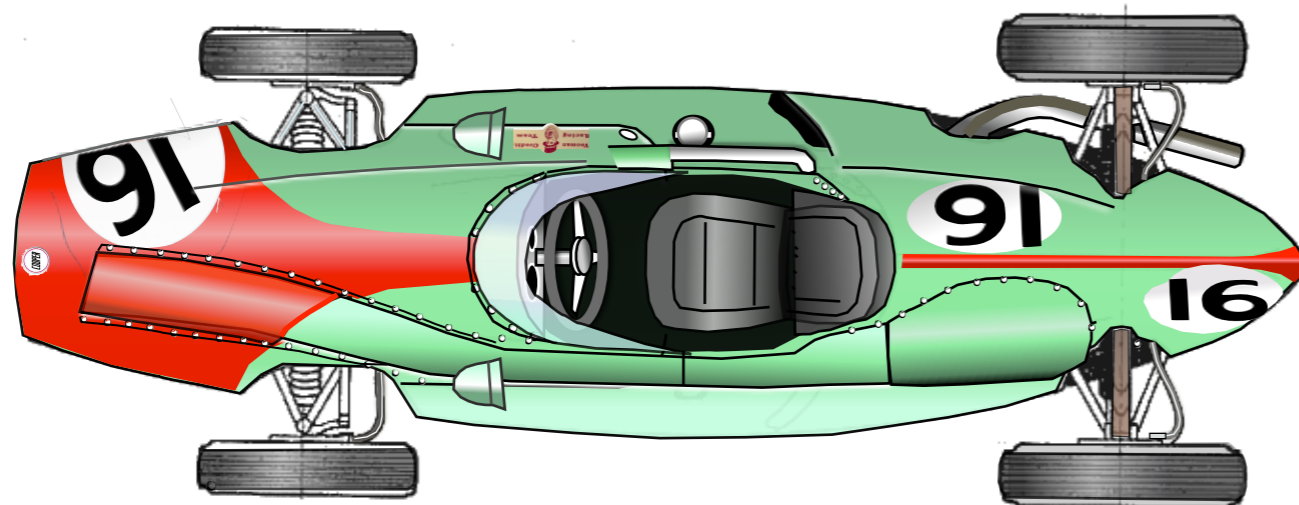
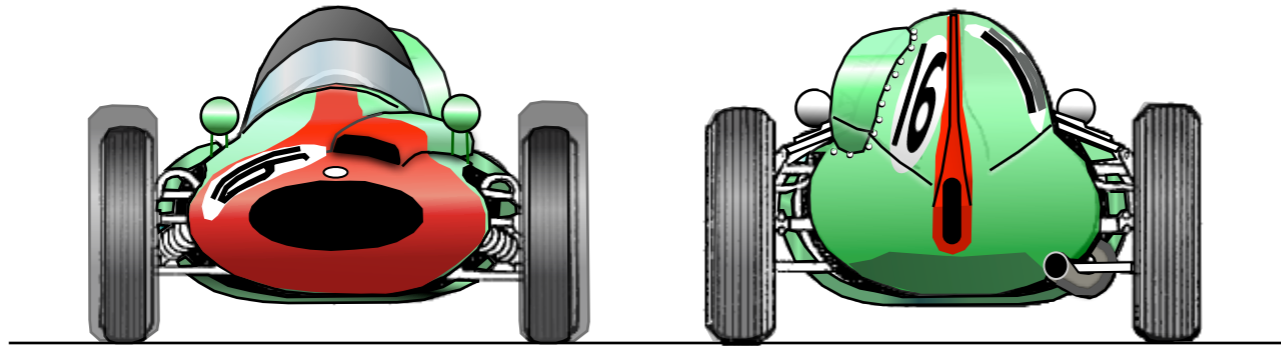

Yeoman Credit was a credit company, owned by three brothers, fanatic of car racing. As a means to promote their company, they decided to sponsor the *British Racing Partnership* private team for the 1960 season. Brand new Cooper T51 cars were bought to compete in the F1 world championship.

The *Yeoman Credit* Cooper T51 cars retained the B.R.P. light green colour, with bright red painted noses, which made the cars very easily recognizable on circuits.

Yeoman Credit will remain one of the first "extrasportifs" sponsors in car racing.



Unfortunately, Chris Bristow, a promising young driver, after a fantastic race at Monaco, was one of the victims of the ill-fated Belgian GP at Spa-Francorchamps.
